

## **Paramedic Student Admissions Checklist**

Once you have signed the Paramedic Enrollment Agreement form, the following documents must be turned in by the first day of class. Failure to do so, may have you removed from the program. Below is everything you will need to have submitted either in person or by email.

> Should you email documents, please download CamScanner or scan in clear images with no shadows.

High School Diploma, High School Transcripts     or GED <u>AND</u> your EMT Certificate	One document supporting you graduated high school AND your EMT Certificate supporting that you graduated.
2. Driver's License	Must not be expired
3. Birth Certificate or Passport	If you turn in your passport, please make sure it is not expired.
4. Social Security Card	If you lost it, you will need to request a replacement card and show proof of purchase.
5. Physical	Your physical needs to state <u>"Patient is free of communicable diseases."</u> Your physical MUST be valid for the entire duration of the program.
6. PPD Test <u>or</u> Chest X-Ray	Must be valid for the duration of the program and you need to include the results that state you do not have tuberculosis.
<ol> <li>MMR, Varicella and Hepatitis B TITERS</li> <li>booster shots are requires if you do not have immunity ***</li> </ol>	You will need to have blood work done to check that you still have immunity to these titers & turn in the lab results to the school. <b>NOT</b> your immunization record unless you just received a booster shot
8. Flu Shot	Highly recommended during flu season
9. COVID Card	Not required or mandatory – however, if you have one please provide a copy of your card/proof of vaccine.
10. BLS Card	Must not be expired
11. EMT License <u>AND</u> NREMT Certificate	NREMT Certificate & EMT Florida State license is required before you are allowed to enter 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester of the program.
12. Background Check	This will be completed on orientation day. If you are not here on orientation day, you will be responsible for completing a <u>LEVEL 2</u> <u>background check</u> at a list of approved locations. Please contact the staff for further information.
13. Drug Screen	You will complete this at the school, either on orientation day or your first day of class
